

To artists working with bojagi

The 2018 International Korea Bojagi Forum will take place in conjunction with the Korea architecture Expo at a major convention center in Seoul.

We are planning two large exhibitions: One of the work of Korean Master artists in bojagi and one of invited international artists who have reinterpreted bojagi in their own ways.

For the international exhibition we invite you to apply the bojagi concept and /or technique into your own work style to create a work especially for this show. Please also provide a written statement on how bojagi inspired you, why you choose this technique, and how bojagi fits into your art and design practice. We would like this show to become a vision statement for the future of bojagi..

Images Requested

Please send images of your beyond bojagi work or work-in-progress by Feb. 28. A committee will make a selection of works for the exhibition by March 15. If your piece is accepted, you will need to send it to Korea in late March along with the exhibition fee of \$100. KBF will cover return shipping of your work after the Forum and include a copy of the 2018 Forum exhibition catalog.

You will be notified of acceptance by mid-March.

For accepted artists, here are further instructions:

- Artists are responsible for shipping costs to Seoul. Use a padded paper envelope or reusable cardboard box. **(No wooden boxes are accepted.)** Please provide, in printing, the return address for shipping back the work after the exhibition.
- KBF will pay return shipping after the exhibition.
- Work should be **WITHOUT a frame**, ready to hang. The piece can be folded or rolled for shipping. Label the package - 'For Exhibit Only- To be returned to Artist'.
- Work size: maximum 60cm - 100 cm in width x 60cm-100 cm or longer in length.
- Accepted Artists must pay the exhibition and catalog fee of \$100 USD/72 Euros, for the production of the full-color catalog and its shipping to the artist. The catalog will cover all the exhibitions that KBF will be hosting and include possible Forum essays.
- Accepted Artists must provide photo release permission to KBF for the production of the catalog and public promotion, including related articles and press releases, etc. This form will be sent along with the acceptance notice.
